JA BizTown® presented by CommunityAmerica Credit Union is a simulated town where 4th–6th grade students take on adult roles for a day. After learning about financial literacy, economics, and business in the classroom, students visit JA BizTown® and become citizens of a student-run economy. They work jobs, earn paychecks, run businesses, and make financial decisions. By the end of the day, they better understand money management, teamwork, and what it takes to succeed in the real world.

### » What do I need to know?

#### YOUR ROLE

Volunteers are assigned to a specific business in the town and serve as mentors for the day. You'll guide 4-10 students through their roles, answer questions, and keep them on track as they complete their tasks.

#### TIME COMMITMENT

Volunteer shifts are typically 4-5 hours between 8:30 am and 2:00 pm.

#### TRAINING

Training is provided on the morning of your shift before students arrive. Just bring your energy, curiosity, and a willingness to jump in!
